Rabies	Single dose as early as 4 months of age, Revaccinate 1 year later and then every 3 years	2 doses, 12 months apart	Required every 3 years, after initial or the 1st 1 year rabies vaccine.
Feline Distemper (Panleukopenia)	As early as 6 weeks, then every 3-4 weeks until 16 weeks of age.	2 doses, 3-4 weeks apart	1 dose is given a year after the last dose of the initial series, then every 3 years.
Feline Herpesvirus	As early as 6 weeks, then every 3-4 weeks until 16 weeks of age	2 doses, 3-4 weeks apart	1 dose is given a year after the last dose of the initial series, then every 3 years.
Calicivirus	As early as 6 weeks, then every 3-4 weeks until 16 weeks of age	2 doses, 3-4 weeks apart	1 dose is given a year after the last dose of the initial series, then every 3 years.
Feline Leukemia Virus (FeLV)	As early as 8 weeks, then 3-4 weeks later	2 doses, 3-4 weeks apart	1 dose is given a year after the last dose of the initial series, then annually
